The fertility rate in Korea has been too low, and it has become a serious social issue. To raise the fertility rate and to support child-rearing in families, the government of Korea has been implementing various policies as well as expanding public expenditures. In spite of those rigorous endeavors, the results have been insufficiently improved.

Against the backdrop, KICCE prepares an international seminar to review policies and public finance on

ECEC from other countries. We expect to find where we are, and also get a chance to explore more efficient ways for public spending. In addition, sharing an innovative case of Holon city (the City of children) in Israel will provide policy implications for our society. We wish that this seminar would be a great opportunity for scholars, politicians, and experts to discuss and expand the perspectives on child care and education.


